**SPEED OF TRAINS THROUGH JUNCTIONS

Until further notice, the maximum permissible speed of trains on the Down and Up Main Lines between the following points must not exceed 90 m.p.h. subject to the observance of all permanent and temporary speed restrictions:—

- Paddington to Plymouth via Lavington
- Reading to Cogload via Swindon and Bristol
- Didcot to Yarnton
- Paddington to Ardley

IMPORTANT.—Until further notice the speed of trains must not exceed 75 miles per hour AT ANY PLACE, except between the points listed above.

Inspectors, Signalmen and others must report to their superior officer every case in which trains run in excess of the speed limits shown below and full particulars must be forwarded at once to the Divisional Traffic Manager.

STANDARD SPEED RESTRICTIONS

When trains are running late, drivers must endeavour to make up time, with due regard to the braking power of the engine and train and provided all speed restrictions are strictly complied with and the maximum speeds indicated are not exceeded.

Trains entering, working over or leaving Goods Lines must not exceed 10 m.p.h., except those Goods Lines situated between Paddington and Penzance via Bath and via Lavington, Old Oak Common and Chester, via Bicester, Didcot and Aynho Junction via Oxford, and Oxford and Wolverhampton via Worcester, where the speed must not exceed 15 m.p.h. or such lower speed as may be indicated.

DIVERTING TRAINS FROM THE MAIN TO THE RELIEF LINE, OR VICE VERSA

1. As far as practicable, every Train must run upon the Line on which it is booked, but whenever it is found necessary to transfer a Train booked *via* the Main Line to the Relief Lines or vice versa, the Signal Box at which the transfer is made must immediately advise the Box in advance by telephone. The message must be sent on from Box to Box, but only as far as to where it may be practicable to re-transfer the Train to its proper Line. Should the Signaller at the latter Box find he cannot re-transfer the Train to its proper Line, he must promptly pass on the message to the next Box from which it must be passed on to the next place where the Train can be re-transferred. One of the objects in sending this advice is to enable persons in charge of Stations in advance to direct passengers to the proper platforms, before the Train arrives; therefore, every dispatch must be used in transmitting the message from Box to Box.

2. The message sent by Telephone must be entered in the Train Register Book together with the time it is received.

3. In ordinary working, a Passenger Train must not be transferred from one Line to another except at the junctions set out below.

4. When a Freight Train has been transferred from one Line to another it is the duty of the Guard to change the side light at the first opportunity.
